- WHEREAS:** Oregon's academic faculty will be participating with thousands of others in all fifty states and Canada seeking recognition of the array of issues being faced by full-time and part-time faculty in our nation's colleges and universities; and
- WHEREAS:** Campus Equity Week seeks the adoption of labor policies and standards that encourage fairness and dignity for all members of the campus community; and
- WHEREAS:** Campus Equity Week is part of a growing movement among working people from all walks of life seeking to address the issues of contingent work; and
- WHEREAS:** Campus Equity Week marks the effort of the major faculty unions, including the American Federation of Teachers-Oregon, as well as other associations and organizations from the US and Canada, that have joined together for an international campaign to promote faculty activism.
